**March 2020 ACM minutes (unapproved)**

Matthew called the Area Committee Meeting to order at 10:13 a.m. via video and teleconference. Alternate Delegate Jenn D. provided a tutorial on using the videoconference interface. Holly (D21) read the Twelve Traditions (short form), Jeremy (D9) read the Twelve Concepts (short form), Jorge (D53) read the Area 07 GSR Preamble, and Drew (D37) read "Why do we Need a Conference?"

**ASSEMBLY REPORTS**

**Pre-Conference**, Holly, D21 DCM for Khristy (Assembly Chair): Assembly has been cancelled in-person. Khristy reached out to the Gold Country Fairgrounds regarding the deposit, which is likely to be returned in light of the Governor's directive to close facilities and cancel

large gatherings. Registration refunds were made. (Card payments were refunded via PayPal pass-thru to bank accounts. Getting group conscience on how to refund other forms of payment.)

**Mini PRAASA**, Brad, Assembly Chair: Not sure if Assembly will occur in person, but we still have a reservation at fairgrounds. **Post-Conference**: No report.

**Hispanic Women's Workshop**, Julie: Event is 12/5 in Granada Hills. At PRAASA, received a packet of "save the date" cards to distribute from 2020 chair, Esther. **Northern California Accessibilities Committee (NCAC)**, Delia: Provided an info table at ACYPAA. At the last meeting, reviewed the ASL interpreter service at ACYPAA serving 5 deaf AA members to attend speaker meetings and panels. Will work with Tulare YPAA for ACYPAA 2021. Looking

### **DCM REPORTS**

**D56, Gilberto:** 11th Anniversary celebration was a success. Meetings cancelled from March 19 through April.

**D55:** no report

**D54, Rafael:** More than 15 groups are closed for the safety of our meetings and COVID-19 until further notice. D54 cancelled its agenda items workshop. Thank you Area 07 for notifying GSRs about what's going on in our Area. PRAASA was a wonderful experience. Bill W. talked about changes happening in the future ...

**D53:** Meetings cancelled with COVID-19

**D11:** No report

**D17, Ryan:** D17 met 3/16 over Zoom in accordance with emailed group conscience. 8 attended. D17 continues to be in good shape financially. Treasurer noticed a significant decrease compared to last year. A fraudulent attempt was

made to withdraw funds through the website. PI/CPC is working with Area 06, going out to schools. Alt DCM shared on PRAASA experience.

**D19, Annette:** D19 meeting was 2/28. Most meetings are closed or going digital. Figuring out how that will work with group members.

**D20, Todd:** One of the meeting halls (6 meetings) is going to online meetings. The other meeting hall is joining existing meetings. Some new online meetings seem like they will stay. Groups have completed agenda topic meetings and gathered group consciences.

**D43, Sherri:** Planning to do group conscience by Zoom. May be starting more soon. Kingsburg (2 meetings per day) were meeting outside, but the weather is changing.

**D21, Holly:** Last D21 meeting was in February before COVID-19. Next meeting 3/24.

Awaiting reports of group conscience on agenda items. Attended PRAASA, roundtable on websites, fantastic experience. Attended marathon

meeting at ACYPAA on remote communities and self-support. Met with IT committee. D21 needs a liaison for Zoom meetings and district registrar.

**D42, Reyna:** Events: 12 Traditions play (5/2); intergroup picnic (5/23). Intergroup is taking phone calls from members' homes and setting appointments for people to come in and buy books, etc. Working on getting Zoom meeting times and numbers. Went to PRAASA and connected with people from Hawaii at the DCM workshop.

**D41, Joshua:** Met 3/10, discussed plans for agenda workshop and attending Pre-Conference Assembly. D41 is subscribing to \$15/month Zoom account. Pre-Conference agenda workshop 3/22 for Fresno and surrounding area.

**D22, Loren:** Thank you to Area Officers who Paneled the 3/11 agenda items workshop. Will be encouraging D22 GSRs to participate in Pre-Conference. PRAASA was awesome. Moderated Literature roundtables. Heard some gender-neutral readings; the meaning was not lost.

**D40, Jackie:** Last D40 meeting was before coronavirus. Considering how do we help people stay safe and still carry the message? Agenda items workshop will be held—depends on GSRs.

**D23, Joseph:** Largest group in D23 has moved to Zoom and started a private/hidden Facebook group. 50 people joined within 24 hours. Members of nearby groups are also joining.

**D37, Larry:** Some GSRs said they are not sure how the informed group conscience through the area would happen if groups are not meeting. Has received some group reports.

**D24, Paul:** Most groups are using Zoom. D24 set up a committee to work on bylaws.

[www.district24cnia.org](http://www.district24cnia.org) will go live soon. GSR School to be held via Zoom. Wants to discuss D24 getting a \$15/month account.

**D36, Julie:** Most meetings have been closed. Secretaries are going to their meeting locations to hand out phone list, newcomer packets and info about Zoom meetings. District meeting 3/22. 6

GSRs will have reports for Pre-Conference.

**D25, Joe:** Some dissention in some meetings about closing, but with county and government mandates, it's essential to lead the way in AA. Has been in contact with GSRs to keep them working together. District meeting 3/11: Trying to get group conscience on questionnaire with 5 items. 8 GSRs planning to participate in Pre-Conference.

**D34, Beth:** Most meetings have moved to Zoom. Our Young People are showing us how to do it.

**D27, Amanda:** Grateful to have a community within the district and connecting with former fellowships. D27's GSR School was held before coronavirus. Attended Sacramento-area agenda items workshop. Spoke on Traditions panel at ACYPAA. Attended DCMs roundtable and YPAA panel at PRAASA. D27 officers reached out to GSRs about agenda topics. Often we hear the question, "Do we think about the newcomer like Bill and Bob thought about us?" especially with the younger

generation growing up with technology.

**D33, Drew:** AA is alive and well in D33. There has been some resistance to shuttering meetings. The Alano Club and other large fellowship, as well as other meetings, have closed. We posted on our local district Facebook page that we have to respect the Governor and shelter in place directive. Has asked D33 to come up with solutions to share meeting information. Grateful to D33 for sending me to PRAASA.

**D55, Luis:** Coronavirus: Most groups are cancelling meetings. Please keep in touch.

**D29, read report:** D29 met via Zoom. Patrick called and emailed GSRs regarding Conference Agenda items. Many groups were unable to hold group conscience meetings due to pandemic advisories. Almost all groups have shut down in-person meetings. Getting in touch with the membership, and polling their feelings on the agenda items is impossible. Discussed an informed group conscience versus knee-jerk reaction to

change. Not everyone has access to technology or understands how to use it effectively. Technology might be excluding people from their right to voice their opinion. Therefore, it would not be a true reflection of the group's conscience. GSRs who were contacted feel that the conference should be postponed until a true reflection of the membership can be gathered and present.

**D30, Michael:** Attended D33's agenda workshop in February. Due to the COVID-19 virus our D. meeting was very small. 6 showed up. Most meetings are postponed until further notice. Attended several meetings before the stay at home order went into effect. It hasn't been very easy to drive to the ACMs, so maybe we could use this tool in addition to the in-person meetings.

### **OFFICERS**

**Delegate, Tom A.:** Thank you for being here and embracing new technology. If we embrace this challenge and face some of these fears, we can move forward. GSO/Conference:

Received an email from Greg T., President/General Manager of AAWS: State of New York is under shutdown and GSO cannot operate. We have contracted with outside vendors to run the General Service Conference remotely. There are no significant reports from GSO. Pre-Conference Assembly: The assembly is cancelled for in-person gathering. Would prefer to receive group conscience on agenda items so we have an informed delegate. Would prefer seeing this on Zoom, or for GSRs to email him: [delegate@cnia.org](mailto:delegate@cnia.org). Some districts say they want to invite Tom to their own individual district group conscience meetings. Tom said he wants to be able to say our Area is ready to send an informed delegate to the Conference.

**Alt. Delegate, Jenn:** Have been able to use professional skill set to be of service in AA work. Pacific Region delegates have agreed to share a Zoom business account, which allows for simultaneous in-meeting interpretation, phone audio access, and other features.

Along with the other areas it will cost \$20/month per area. The E-Services committee will talk about using technology that everybody has access to. PI/CPC is on hold but we are exploring how to continue meeting. Jenn encouraged DCMs to connect with local intergroup offices or entities that host local websites. For example, in Chico, meetings are sharing information with teleservice.

**Chair, Matthew:** Prior to the shutdown, our area had been holding agenda item workshops. Attended ACYPAA, spoke on a panel and had a lot of fun at the event. Attended PRAASA, but had a cold that turned into pneumonia. Has been in touch with other area officers from the Pacific Region.

**Alternate Chair, Claudio:** Did 15 GSR Schools. Took a break before PRAASA. Attended some agenda item workshops. Thank you to Jenn and area officers to put this together with technology and embracing a change. Linguistic districts are working through a lot of patience.

**Treasurer, Margie:** Regarding meetings distributing 7th Tradition collection from their “virtual basket” – CNIA.org website’s contributions button needs to be worked on. New group numbers are not yet available from registrar.

**Registrar, Herminia:** Until further notice, info will be emailed. The updated Area Committee contact list for March 2020 was emailed to the Area Officers, DCMs and Past Delegates.

Information for groups, mailing lists, special reports will be updated. GSO’s NetSuite software system was scheduled to roll out at the end of March 2020. DCMs and GSRs packets are taking 3–4 months to be received. Attended PRAASA and went to the Registrar workshop which was very informative. Participated on a panel at ACYPAA.

**Recording Secretary, Kendyce:** Participated in agenda items workshop in Redding. Attended PRAASA, went to roundtables on website & newsletters, seniors, YPAA, and Interactive Ask-it Basket. Kendyce

discussed how to submit reports by email.

Continuing on, Area officers shared about their experiences at PRAASA.

### **Committees**

**E-Services, Mike K.** for Patrick: Met via Zoom 3/20/2020. Members are Patrick, Holly, Annette, Margie, Mike K. Discussed YTD contributions, which look low. Area finances may be affected since most meetings have been suspended due to COVID-19. The committee agreed to monitor the finances and review bank statements quarterly.

**Finance:** Holly shared a document about the Seventh Tradition that she had shared in D21.

We took a break from 12:18 to 12:30 p.m. The meeting reconvened at 12:39 p.m.

### **Appointed Chairs**

**Accents, Celia:** Our printer is still in operation and the hardcopy Accents and Acentos were expected to be sent for April. Thank you to our new Written Translation chair, Amanda



H, and the rest of the translation crew for their work on the March Acentos and other items. Thank you for funding me to PRAASA, even though it seems so long ago now.

**Bridging the Gap**, Jason: Went to a sharing session on BTG. Passing a Gold Can may be a new option for helping with accessibilities services. Communicating with Area 06. BTG presentations in facilities have been on hold. Distributed 5 requests and received successful contacts for those.

**Written Translation**, Amanda: Starting to receive material from Celia and others, and is returning translations by the deadline. If anyone needs something, let her know.

**Grapevine**, Brad: March started with spreading the message to ACYPAA. Went to the Saturday night speaker meeting. "A Rabbit Walks into a Bar" and "Take me to your Sponsor" were popular sellers. Meeting and talking to people about Grapevine and recovery was the best part. Attended agenda

items workshop in Loomis before the coronavirus.

**Literature**, Julie: Made literature available at ACYPAA. The big sellers were pocket size Big Books (sold 4) and 12x12's (sold 3). Attended PRAASA this year, and made a literature contact during a roundtable session who has also been working on an inventory and tracking spreadsheet.

## GSR Preamble

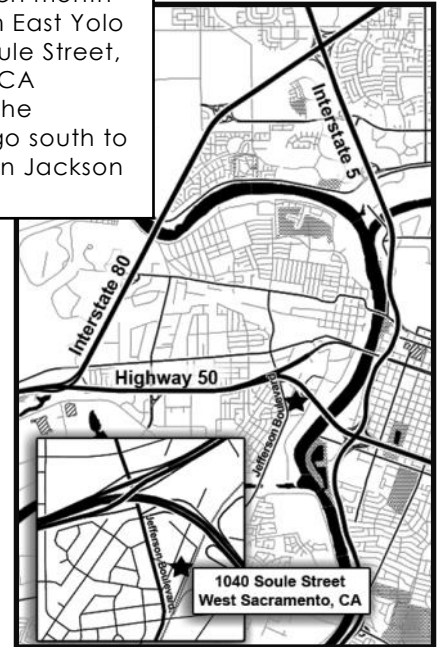
We are the General Service Representatives. We are the link in the chain of communication for our groups with the General Service Conference and the world of A.A.

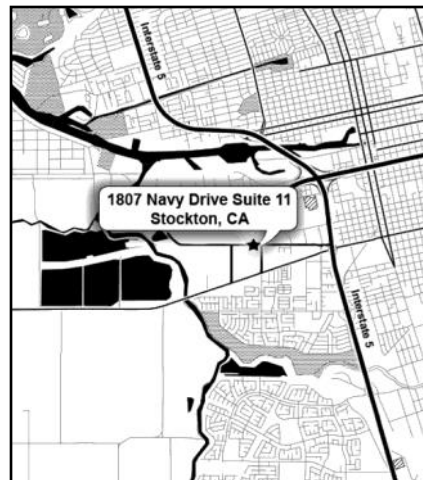
