



What

- Events or workshops
- New district or area officers
- Things your group may relate to, is interested, or involved in
- Things you learned at an area assembly
- If a district or area issue comes up that requires a vote:
 - Try to explain it simply, fully, and fairly so your group can arrive at an informed group conscience

When

- Well, how often does your group have business meetings?
- Does your group allow GSR reports during regular meetings?

How (long)

 You'll hear many suggestions... think about how long you pay attention / stay engaged for?



Things to note:

- There's a difference between "Consider" "Review" and "Discuss"
 - Consider = first time it's on the agenda, so we're considering the request
 - Discuss = it's been on the agenda before, and there's more to discuss
 - Review = something's been drafted and needs review
 (often not by the fellowship)

- A. Review GSO general manager's report regarding General Service Conference site selection.
- B. Review clates for the 2029 General Service Conference.
- C. Discuss Equitable Distribution of Workload (EDW) progress report and draft plan
- D. Discuss the process of Simple Majority Items.
- E. Consider request that a Super Majority of voting members be required to change or amend Founders Literature.
- While most agenda items are organized by committee, some may appear in unexpected places to ensure an equitable distribution of work
- The delegate isn't necessarily looking for a group conscience - take lots of notes on individual comments


