Feedback ACMs, Workshops, Surveys, Emails and Calls 2025-10

All,

With input at ACMs, workshops, surveys, emails and calls, we have made a few changes. Thank you!

Generally speaking, the following seems apparent – we are currently planning to overspend \$4,167 (or have that as a deficit).

- 1. The majority support keeping mileage reimbursement at to 0.70/mi.
- -We considered less but there were concerns about principles and practical issues.
- -Unrelated, since last month, we reduced cost of mileage in two ways:
- --From chairs mileage was included for ACMs, which are not technically required; this saved a little under \$3,000.
- --Interpreter mileage to ACMs; that costs about \$450 less.
- 2. We have put contributions at \$66,000.
- -There is much more support for raising contributions from \$64,000 current to \$66,000 and less support for \$68,000 instead.
- -\$66,000 is more incremental and may be more prudent.
- 3. The majority support for 8 PRAASA and 4 special conferences this year only due to travel to Hawaii.
- -This costs \$11,200; last year we spend \$15,200
- -Some suggest more go (10 or all); the Finance Committee considered this and sending less, too.
- -This is how many learn their role and a key part of training.
- -The Finance Committee suggests that we send 7 officers and pick 1 chair out of the hat. We do not think an ad hoc comm is needed. That leaves 3 chairs not attending any conference, unless an officer cannot go and then could pick another chair out of the hat. We do not support AV tech attending PRAASA.
- 4. There appears to be good support for moving 2 ACMs to virtual (in total/year).
- -We kept that in the calculations (savings of \$3,500).
- -In the future, if we change an assembly and replace an ACM, we'd still stop at 2/year for now and re-evaluate).
- 5. Overspending by \$4,167; last year it was \$3,402.52.
- -Traditionally, businesses want no overspending, but in AA we do things a little differently
- -Jenn D. looked at spending plan totals 2011-2024: we spend only 83% of what is planned. We are a little better estimating and have tightened up the spending plan over the last few years, though.
- -We collected information on whether it is okay plan to overspend \$5,000 or \$10,000 (or 5% or 10% of the plan) most were okay with \$5,000 but very few support \$10,000.
- 6. Compared to last year, we increased mileage reimbursement for GSC workshops and for mileage unreimbursed other district mileage to \$1,200 and \$1,200.
- 7. Compared to last year, we increased the GSC contribution from \$3,600 to \$5,000.
- -The overwhelming majority support this.
- -This is to be more self-supporting; it actually costs about $$10,\!000$$ and General Service Board/Office picks up the rest.

- 8. Other suggestions...
- -Rent for ACMs and storage is being re-evaluated; if it works out, that may save \$500-\$1,500.
- -Since Pacific Regional Forum is in San Diego, it costs will be less and maybe consider sending another person?

Other things FYI

Assembly Ad Hoc Committee is considering

- All assemblies two days = \$2,500 less (2027?)
 - o Comment: move to two-day Election/Mini-PRAASA (maybe have a one-day virtual one for the 'work')
- An additional, one-day virtual assembly 1 day in August or September (and subtract an ACM = actual cost \$1,750 and translation \$450) = \$2,200 less (2027?)
 - o Note: if a virtual assembly would be August (as GSC agenda items due mid-September)
- One day Post-Conference Assembly \$1,000 less (2027?)

Area still is reflecting on whether to

- Phase out Oral Translation? **\$0** (not filled) most do not support this.
 - o Sense of the room: overall, support, as well, no one is stepping up
- Phase out Written Translation to artificial intelligence or such there is mixed support for this. It would save 2,500?

Conferences and PRAASA

- Background
 - History: 16 PRAASA & 7 special conferences; not including Linguistic/Hispanic Conference?
 - 2025: 13 PRAASA & 3 special conferences= \$16,000 actual?
 - 2026:
 - o Draft with 8 PRAASA (\$11,200) and 4 special conferences (\$4,000) = about \$15,200?
 - Alternatively, could <u>cap</u> funding for PRAASA at \$9,000/year and special conferences at \$3,000?
 - o Need a meaningful way to decide who goes (e.g., Area need, alternate, or random?)
- Comments
 - Cap it per person at like \$800 and folks pay the rest if they want to go; right of participation
 - Chairs should not have to choose between PRAASA and a special conference it is our job to go to these
 - Chairs really have to choose between PRAASA and a special conference ... a matter of \$, really
 - Hesitant to cut conferences, in general, as this is important grooming of leaders as part of our service work
 - PRAASA may be \$1,200/person rather than \$1,400 (e.g., cheaper flights, 3 folks/room, other)?
 - Suggest AV Tech not be a PRAASA attendee
 - What are the special conferences: BTG, GV/LV, Archives, NAATW; NCCAA and Hispanic one are different, so to speak.
