

Things to consider when reviewing your group literature rack...

1. You can check the publication date on your pamphlets on the back. If they are older than 10 years old, they have most likely been updated so you should order new pamphlets and throw those away. You can keep one for Archives.
2. Even if you do not have Spanish speakers attend, have a couple of basic literature pieces in Spanish.
3. Having a variety of pamphlets like LGBTQ Alcoholics in A.A., Black in A.A., Indigenous People in A.A., Young People in A.A. help people who may not see themselves represented in the room know they have a place in A.A.
